




During the Liturgy of the Word we listen to readings from the bible.

The people who wrote these readings were inspired by the Holy Spirit to do so.


Therefore the Bible is <u>The Word of God</u> and this helps us to know how God wants us to live.





Now my heart is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour?'






THE MARTYRS SHRINE AT THE TOP OF REDHILL





COMMUNION




We will now <u>share communion together</u> by either receiving the Body of Jesus or a blessing.

This is a most special time within the Mass and should be treated with great reverence.


Father and Mr. McCormack will now outline how we should respond during communion.

Everyone is invited to come forward to receive Holy Communion or a blessing






