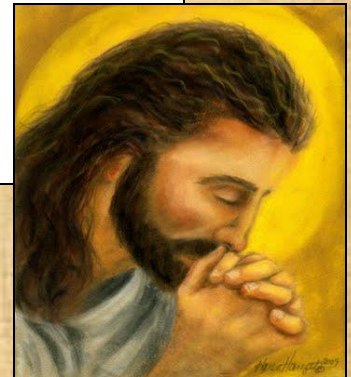


## PLEASE STAND

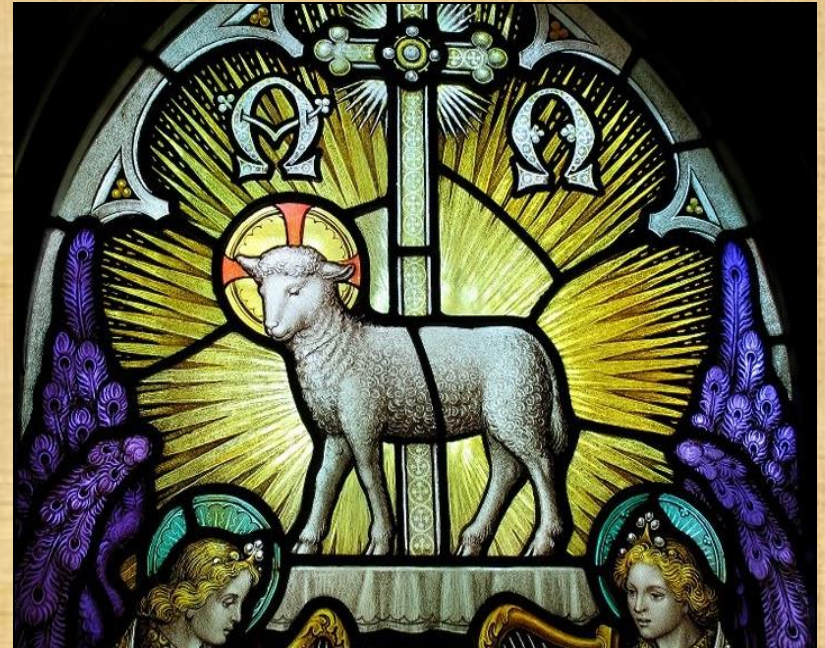

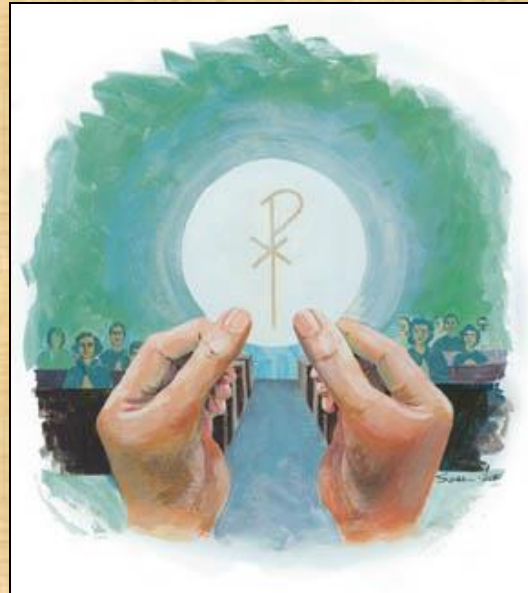

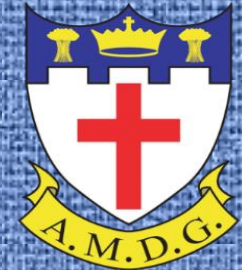

This is a most special time within the Mass and should be treated with great reverence.

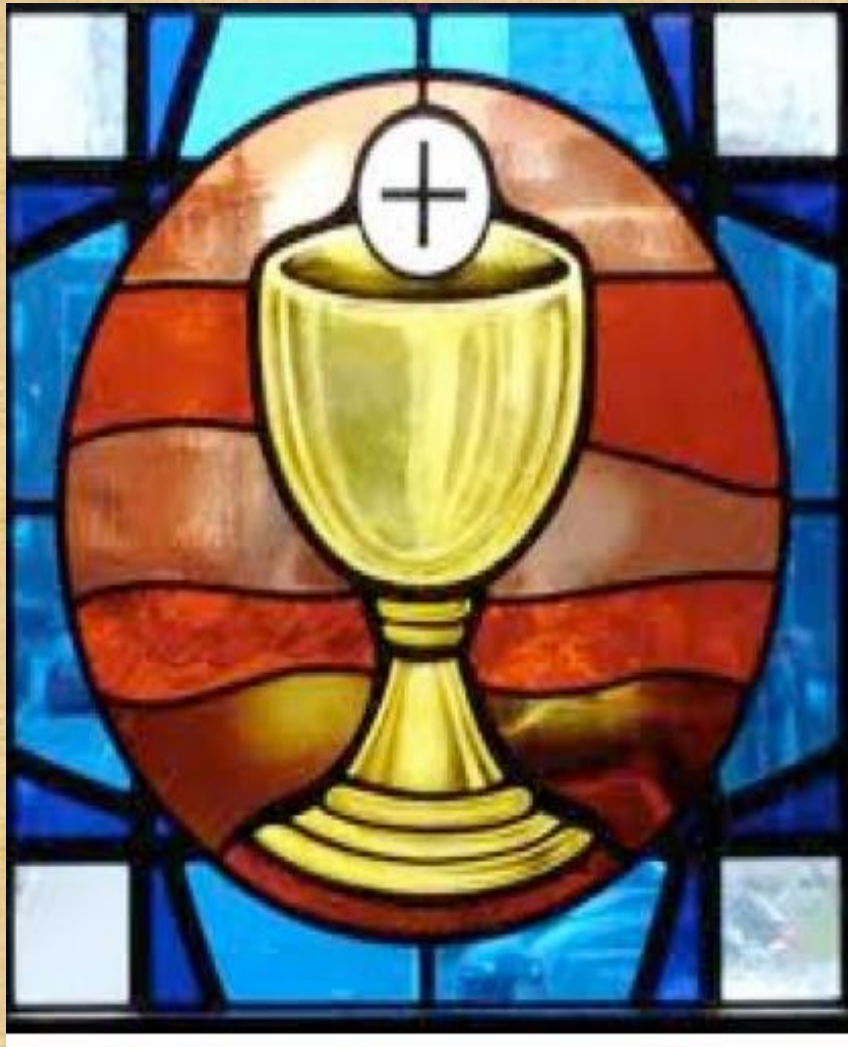
