




During the Liturgy of the Word, we listen to <u>readings from the bible</u>.

Therefore, the Bible is <u>The Word of God</u> and this helps us to know how God wants us to live.




THE LITURGY OF THE WORD

Our First Reading is a prayer from <u>St. Paul</u>



He prays that we will grow strong in the different areas of our lives.



Then, planted in love, and built on love, with all God's holy people, you will have the strength to grasp the breadth and the length, the height, and the depth of God's love.





With the coming of evening that same day, Jesus said to them, "Let us cross over to the other side."






We will now <u>share communion together</u> by either receiving the Body of Jesus or a blessing.

This is a most special time within the Mass and should be treated with great reverence.


