and the depth of God's love.

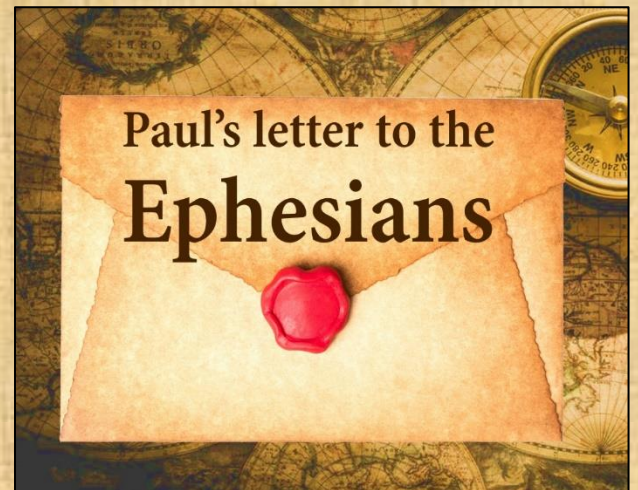
