





In all that we do and say, we pray that, in building up the community of our school, we may contribute to the betterment of society and to the Kingdom of your Son, Jesus Christ,


all - For the Greater Glory of God.






#### THE LITURGY OF THE WORD




Brothers, do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

For as in one body, we have many members, and not all the members have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members of one another.






6. We pray for Mary, the Mother of God. Let us never fail to acknowledge the unconditional love that she bestows upon us as we all say together -


## College Prayer


