Section A Shakespeare (40 mark) 1 hour

6.2 Essay (25 marks) 40 minsOne character/theme will be assessed in 6.2.The question will be:Write about Shylock and how he is presented in different points in the play.

Section B. Poetry Anthology 1 hour

15 marks single poem 20 mins

25 marks compare poems 40 mins

1 poem will be printed in the exam paper.

You will be asked to write about how the above poem presents the theme of nature/ power and **compare** it to one other poem of your choice from the anthology. You will need to remember the second poem you chose to write about. You have prepared for this during lesson time. Use your class resources.

SECOND EXAM

Lit C2 2.5 hours 120 marks 60%

Section A.

An Inspector Calls (35 + 5 spag marks) 45 mins

Write about the theme of **responsibility** and how it is presented at different points in the play.

Section B. A Christmas Carol (40 marks) 45 mins

Revise key themes:

Poverty, the poor Charity Christmas Transformation Ghosts Turning points 1834 Poor Law Malthus
