WE LISTEN



These words from the book of Wisdom seem especially relevant today, on the anniversary of the martyrdom of Saint Oscar Romero. He was murdered on this day in 1980 while saying Mass as the Archbishop in El Salvador. This remarkable man refused to stay quiet in the face of inequality, injustice and increasing violence in his country. He was a brave defender of the poorest and most vulnerable people and called on the army to stop killing people.

Even when faced with death threats he remained steadfast in his support. In his final homily, just moments before he was murdered, Romero said: "Those who surrender to the service of the poor through love of Christ will live like the grain of wheat that dies. It only apparently dies. If it were not to die, it would remain a solitary grain. The harvest comes because of the grain that dies..."

Rooted in love, the life of Saint Oscar Romero continues to bear a harvest of goodness today. His deep commitment to the poor and passionate belief in justice continues to inspire many, including the work of CAFOD.

Saint Bernadette was born in Lourdes on the 7th of January 1844 and died on April 16 1879. She is the Patron saint of illness, people ridiculed for their faith, poverty, shepherds and Lourdes. While she was alive, she saw 18 apparitions of Mary, the mother of God, in a cave on the outskirts of Lourdes, now known as the Grotto. She died of Tuberculosis at the age of 35. She was made a saint on the 8th December 1933.

During the sacred season of Lent, bring me closer to you.

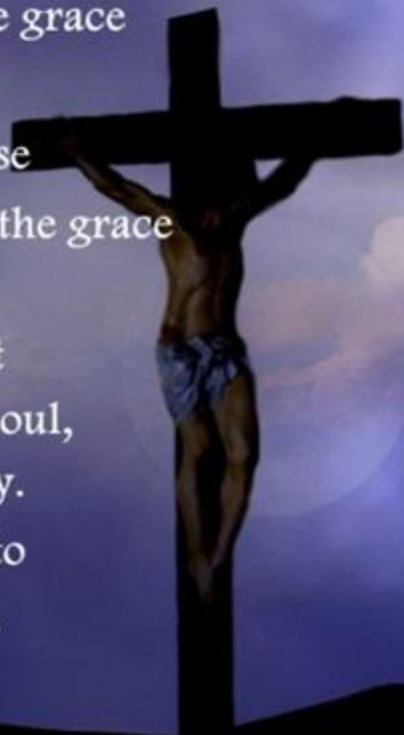
Prepare a place in my home and heart for silence and solitude, so that I may re-discover the grace of a prayer-full life.
