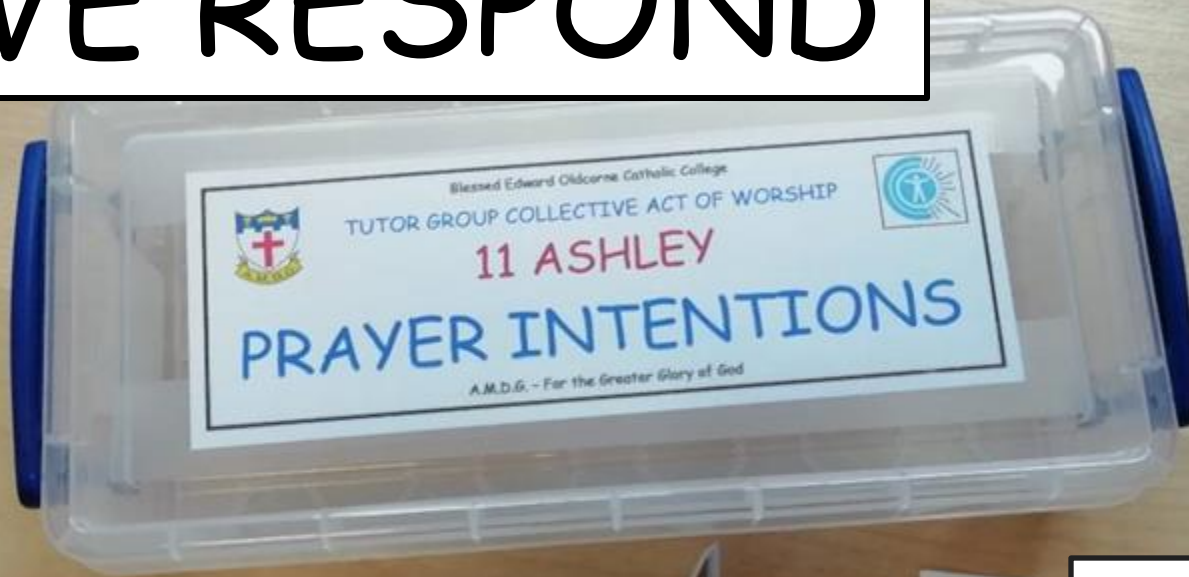
# WE LISTEN

## The Feast Day of St Joseph

Today we celebrate the Feast of St Joseph, a mysterious biblical character in some ways. We know little about him, and he does not speak at all in the Gospels.

He is, however, a man of action. He obeys the Angel's command and takes Mary as his wife despite her being pregnant with a baby that he knows is not his; he travels to Bethlehem for the census and finds the family shelter and when Jesus' life is threatened by Herod, he takes his family to safety in Egypt. 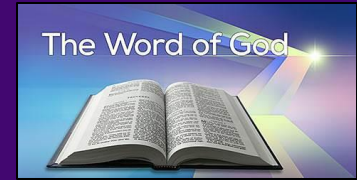
# WE LISTEN



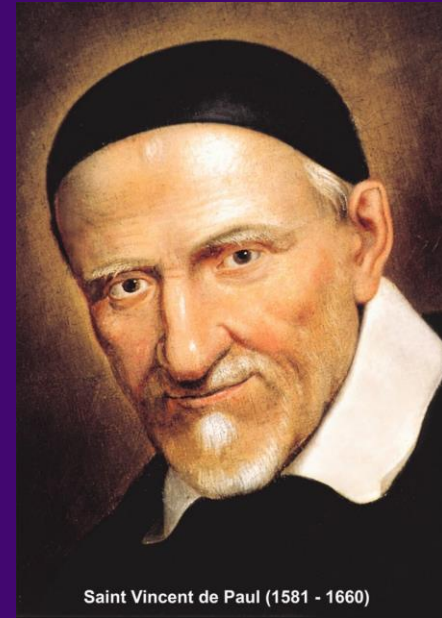

Vincent de Paul was born on the 24th of April 1581 and he died on the 27th of September 1660. Saint Vincent de Paul was a French Catholic priest who dedicated himself to serving the poor. The Catholic Church celebrates St. Vincent de Paul's feast day on September 27th. Most of us know his common life. He was born poor in the French village of Pouy on April 24, 1581. He founded the Congregation of the Mission and the Daughters of Charity with St. Louise de Marillac. He died on September 27th, 1660.
